Abstract:

The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed vulnerabilities in healthcare supply chains. What are the lessons learned? How to develop resilience healthcare supply chains proactively?

Bio:

Prof. Christopher Tang is a University Distinguished Professor and the holder of the Edward W. Carter Chair in Business Administration at the UCLA Anderson School of Management. He has been elected as Fellow of INFORMS, MSOM society, and POM society. Known as a thought leader in global supply chain management, Chris consulted with numerous global companies including Amgen, Amazon, HP, IBM, Nestlé (USA), etc.; taught at Stanford University, UC Berkeley, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, National University of Singapore, MIT (Zaragoza), and London Business School.

Chris has published 7 books, 30 book chapters, over 200 research articles in global supply chain management. He has also published over 100 articles in public media, including Wall Street Journal, Financial Times, Barron's, Bloomberg Law, Forbes, Fortune, Los Angeles Times, South China Morning Post, China Daily, etc. He received his B.Sc. (First class honours in Mathematics) from King's College, London, M.A (in Statistics), M.Phil. (in Administrative Science), and PhD (in Management Science) from Yale University.
